WELCOME TO OUR SCHOOL

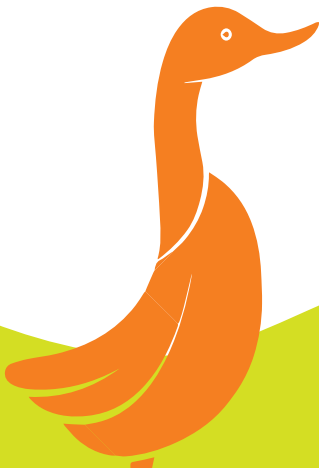

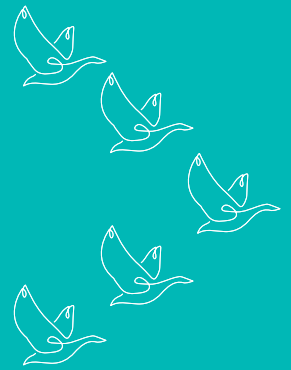

We respect and protect each other in times of challenge, working with our parents to support our pupils. High quality teaching will empower our children to achieve success.

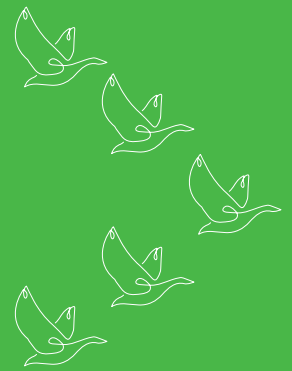

STARTING SCHOOL

WORKING WITH PARENTS

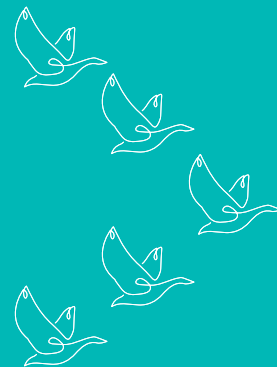

Parents' Evenings:

We encourage parents to attend two Parents' Evenings each year:

- Before half term in the Autumn Term, you are invited into school to discuss how your child has settled into his/her new class and the progress they are making towards their own curriculum targets.
- In the Spring Term we invite you to come into school with your child to discuss their progress.
- During the Summer Term all parents will receive a written report.
- At any time there are concerns we welcome the opportunity for discussion.





EARLY YEARS

Our School has both its own Pre-School and Nursery class which are a part of our vibrant Early Years unit. These are all within a modern and purpose built building and offer your children security and happiness. We take children from the age of 2 and offer all year round provision from 8:00am - 6:00pm.

The children enter the River room at 2-3 years old moving into the Upton Nursery class from 3-4 years old. They then join the Reception class during the year they turn 5 years old, following application for the School.

KEY STAGE 1

Our Key Stage 1 unit is made up of classes 1 and 2. It builds on the firm foundation the children have experienced in the Early Years setting. Our curriculum covers phonics, reading, writing and mathematical development, encompassing the wide variety of other aspects through a theme based learning platform.

The two classes are well equipped with a shared creative area, offering facilities for adventurous art projects!



KEY STAGE 2

Within the Key Stage 2 unit are classes 3-6. We aspire to outstanding teaching ensuring the children's attainment and progress are closely monitored to enable all children to flourish.

The curriculum is presented in a stimulating and positive way to ensure the children are inspired in their learning. The teachers work together and a variety of exciting and captivating events are planned for the introduction of the pupil focussed half termly topics. This motivational approach is rooted within a team ethos and creates a warm and vibrant learning environment.



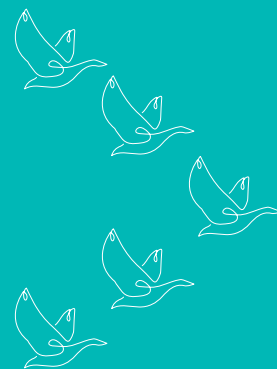
