Year 1 -
Plants

Year 1 are doing all their science learning about plants in their FS sessions. Today we read the story Sam plants a sunflower by Kate Petty. We had a wonderful discussion about where plants come from and why plants are important. Some children could articulate their brilliant knowledge to share with the class. The children used fine motor skills to make their own paper plant pots, and each planted one of three different types of seed (sunflower, tomato or nasturtium) and the children predicted which plant they would grow into. We are going to check on the seeds each week and measure the progress.
