THIS WEEK IN FOREST SCHOOL...

Today we shared the story of *The Mixed up Chameleon* by Eric Carle. We talked about the word camouflage and how invertebrates and other animals use it for survival. We split into two teams - hiders and finders. The hiders were given some coloured matchsticks and we predicted which colours would be easier or harder to find. They then hid them around Forest School. The finders then had to search for the matchsticks. We revisited our predictions and discussed which colours were more camouflaged or were found more easily.
