We started our first session back after the holidays by looking at the changes in Forest School. So many trees have now got leaves and everywhere is looking so much greener. We listened to a story about a listening walk and we then listened carefully to see what human-made sounds and natural sounds we could hear. This required the children to persevere, to stay focussed and identify what they heard. Some of the children enjoyed planting some sunflower seeds - we are hoping these will be great for pollinators later in the summer. Other children found a snail and made it a home that was comfy and had lots of leaves to munch demonstrating care for the environment and God's creatures. Whilst other curious learners created a river and investigated different materials that could be made into good boats. They discovered that bark works best.
