

THIS WEEK IN FOREST SCHOOL...

Year 1 -
Plants

For the last session of this half term we worked in teams to survey small sections of the grass to see how diverse the plants and insects were. The children identified and named plants such as daisy, dandelion, clover and buttercup as well as looking for insects. They counted how many of each plant that they could find. We then discussed our findings together and tried to guess where they had surveyed depending on the largest number of plants. Other children then made leaf bugs using natural materials, showing care to use materials that they had found or were careful to pick only what they needed. Some children were fascinated by a miner bee and sat and watched it for some time.
