Today we shared the story of Owl Babies by Martin Waddell, the children listened attentively and responded to what they heard, making comments and asking questions. They explored the world around them and made observations by using mirrors to look up into the treetops, noticing that the trees had been cut back and looked for bird's nests. The children also had experience of using the digging tools to dig and fill buckets with the new wood chippings. Through this they learned that there is a need for rules to be safe as well as playing co-operatively and taking turns.
