Reception - Celebrations

Today we began our session by reading the story of Kipper's Birthday as we were reading the children tried to anticipate what might happen as Kipper had not given all the right information on his invitations. We shared and discussed different ways in which we celebrate. The children created a group of musicians to perform songs with others so they could play some birthday games. Others created invitations and birthday banners drawing on their understanding and personal experiences. Some children persevered to tie leaves to create Forest School bunting. We shared some warm squash as it was such a cold day - the children confidently embraced the new experience and observed how the squash felt in their hands. The session ended with a few rounds of musical statues where the children tried to move in time with the music performed by the forest school band.
