Today we shared *The Snail and the Whale* by Julia Donaldson. We started by asking the children to think mathematically and think how big a whale was - we had some interesting and varied ideas! We then laid down head to toe to measure its length. The children then counted how many steps it took them to get from one end to the other. Some children continued to be fascinated by bug hunting - some children found different coloured ladybirds and we had an interesting discussion about whether ladybirds were poisonous or not. Others experimented with PVA glue and natural materials to make their own snail trail messages.
